Census

Our World Service Office census (2008) estimated that there are 54,000 members in the Fellowship, with 41,540 in the US and 12,460 in the rest of the world. The census was mailed to 5,393 registered OA meetings worldwide — 4,420 in the US and 1,571 outside the US — and found that meetings have, on average, have about eight to nine members attending regularly.

News

On May 1, the delegates at OA's World Service Business Conference (WSBC) 2010 adopted a motion to add a ninth tool called "Action Plan." The Conference Literature Committee is working on a definition that will be presented for adoption to WSBC 2011. Until that time, OA members are free to interpret "Action Plan" as they wish.

Recovery from compulsive eating is the most important thing in our lives without exception! The Twelve Steps are the heart of the OA recovery program. They offer a new way of life that enables the compulsive eater to live without the need for excess food. By working the Twelve Steps, we develop a new way of thinking and acting which enables us to live one day at a time without eating compulsively. When confronted with the urge to eat excess or inappropriate food, we now have alternatives.
