## OACIIG BOARD ELECTIONS TO BE HELD IN OCTOBER!

CIIG Board elections will be held on Tuesday, October 1st at 7:30 pm at the Carpinteria Community Church. There are currently no abstinence requirements to serve on the CIIG board, and you must be present at the October meeting in order to be considered for election.

Service on the CIIG board is fun, rewarding, a great opportunity to meet other OAers in the intergroup area (Camarillo, Ventura, Ojai, Carpinteria, Santa Barbara, and Goleta), and an excellent way to promote your recovery in OA.

#### **Requirements (From the CIIG Bylaws):**

- a. Service Board Election of these officers to the Board of OACII will be held at the regular OACII meeting in October, unless otherwise changed by majority of the voting body of a meeting of the OACII. Terms for one year, with a maximum of one re-election to the same office (i.e. An officer may not serve more than two (2) years in a single office without interruption.)
- i. CHAIRPERSON: Chairs all OACII meetings, is unofficial member of all committees and all OACII-sponsored activities.

- ii. VICE-CHAIRPERSON: Fills in for absent chairperson, helps to oversee all OACII-sponsored activities and updates group registration in cooperation with Overeaters Anonymous World Service Office (WSO).
- iii. RECORDING SECRETARY: Takes minutes at OACII meetings and brings copies of minutes to the following meeting for distribution.
- iv. BUSINESS SECRETARY: Handles incoming and outgoing correspondence of the OACII Board.
- v. TREASURER: Handles the financial statements and pays expenses of the OACII.
